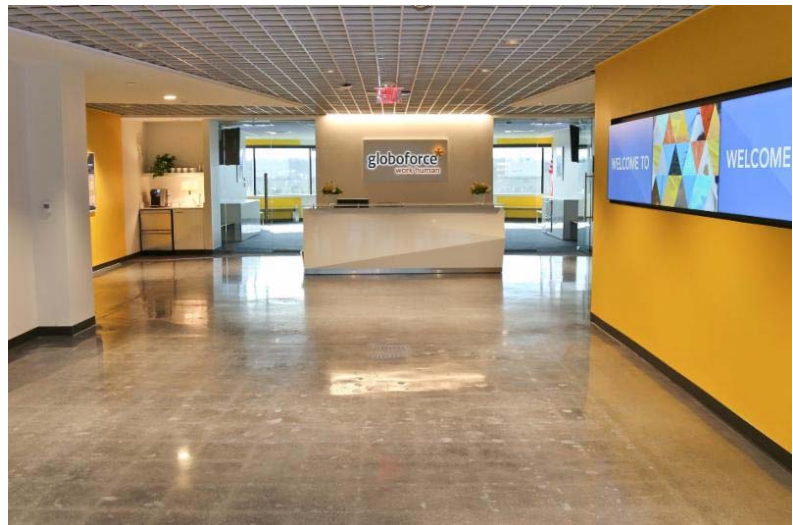

Software Company opens new HQ in Framingham

On March 20th, international software company [Globoforce](#)

During its final session, which closed on May 2nd, Framingham's annual Town Meeting voted to support a number of projects that will improve Framingham's infrastructure and promote economic development. Taken together, these decisions highlight community commitment to make Framingham a great place to live, work, and play.

Town Meeting voted to support the design for a new fire station on A Street in North Framingham. Members also voted to support the rehabilitation of Village Hall in Framingham Center to make the historic structure handicap accessible. Additionally, they supported additional funds for Loring Skating Arena, a seasonally-operated skating facility, which recently underwent renovations.

With regard to important infrastructure improvements, members approved improvements at the intersection of Edgell, Water, and Edmands Streets in the Nobscot neighborhood. They also granted authority to the municipality to acquire easements on Marble Street in Downtown Framingham to support a residential real estate project at 266 Waverly Street.

Finally, members also voted to fund an account for the Economic Development and Industrial Corporation (EDIC), which will allow the corporation to hire an economic development specialist to support its activities promoting Framingham. They also passed a resolution to promote renewable energy. In total, Town Meeting approved a \$280 million municipal operating budget for FY 2018.

"These decisions reflect the Town's desire for updated facilities and

Globoforce recently opened a new facility in Framingham. Describe the new facility and how it benefits Globoforce.

Globoforce's new state-of-the-art headquarters in Framingham is designed to

represent Globoforce's mission to inspire greater humanity, productivity and teamwork in the workplace. The new headquarters encompasses more than 55,000 square-feet and occupies two floors. The facility also focuses on promoting cross-functional collaboration and inclusion, enabling more than 3 million employees around the world to have positive experiences at work. What amenities does the new facility bring to Globoforce?

The human-centric office space features digital walls, floor-to-ceiling glass windows, stairwells with inspirational messages, phone booths for personal phone calls, collaboration spaces, relaxation areas and a game area. Additionally, the office includes a wellness room that offers yoga, meditation and amenities for new mothers, while the Globocafe provides employees with healthy snacks, a coffee bar and a grassy area with Adirondack chairs.

Why did you choose Framingham for the new facility?

accommodate the company's continued growth. When picking a new space, the company looked at approximately 40 potential locations, while also surveying employees to evaluate commute times. Globoforce ultimately chose Framingham because of its central location between Boston and the outer boroughs, making it easily accessible for employees, as well as the company's many visitors to the office, including customers and partners.

There are currently more than 200 U.S. employees working at the Framingham facility with ample room for future growth. The company also continues to grow its roster of customers, which currently includes such leading companies as The Hershey Co., JetBlue Airways, Baystate Health and InterContinental Hotels Group (IHG).

Globoforce also recently unveiled its new 45,000 square foot Dublin headquarters and plans to create 100 jobs over the next three years as the company continues to expand globally.

[Sofá Café](#) is the newest coffee house and café in downtown Framingham (at 181 Concord Street). It all began in Sao Paulo, Brazil in 2011 due to a simple and abiding love for coffee. Six years later, Sofá Café is now considered

one of Brazil's best cafes. After opening four locations there, they brought their business to the United States. Its first U.S. location opened on Newbury Street in Boston but has now moved right here to downtown Framingham!

When you come to Sofá Café, you will have a unique coffee experience - and that's how they want it to stay. They only use specialty coffee - from all over the world, though they will soon be roasting their own coffee right here in Framingham, as well. When making your coffee, they promote a "slow coffee experience," meaning the beans are ground on demand and the coffee is brewed right in front of you. You can choose four pour over options: Chemex, Hario v60, Aeropress and French press. And, while you wait for your coffee experience, you can enjoy a cozy spot on a couch or sit at a table to work (with free wifi!), talk with friends, or simply enjoy some time to yourself. The team at Sofá Café wants you to enjoy the quality coffee, the experience of drinking it, the quality of the food and the space.
